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# Broadband access in the EU as at 1 July 2007

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#### **DEFINITIONS**

Definitions used in the tables for the collection of data:

- Fully unbundled lines: Fully unbundled lines supplied to other operators, excluding experimental lines. In the case of full unbundling, a copper pair is rented to a third party for its exclusive use.
- Shared access lines supplied by the incumbent to new entrants: Shared access lines supplied to other operators, excluding experimental lines. In the case of shared access, the incumbent continues to provide telephony service, while the new entrant delivers high-speed data services over that same local loop.
- Bitstream access: Supplied to new entrants. Bitstream access refers to the situation where the incumbent installs a high-speed access link to the customer premises and then makes this access link available to third parties, to enable them to provide high-speed services to customers. Bitstream depends in part on the PSTN and may include other networks such as the ATM network, and bitstream access is a wholesale product that consists of the provision of transmission capacity in such a way as to allow new entrants to offer their own, value-added services to their clients. The incumbent may also provide transmission services to its competitor, to carry traffic to a 'higher' level in the network hierarchy where new entrants may already have a broadband point of presence.
- Simple resale: In contrast to bitstream access, simple resale occurs where the new entrant receives and sells on to end users with no possibility of value added features to the DSL part of the service a product that is commercially similar to the DSL product provided by the incumbent to its own retail customers, irrespective of the ISP service that may be packaged with it. Resale offers are not a substitute for bitstream access because they do not allow new entrants to differentiate their services from those of the incumbent (i.e. where the new entrant simply resells the end-to-end service provided to him by the incumbent on a wholesale basis).
- Incumbent's DSL lines: Provided to end users by the incumbent, its subsidiaries or partners (for example an associated company such a joint venture providing ISP services),
- WLL: Internet broadband connections by means of wireless local loop (sometimes referred to as fixed wireless access)
- Cable modem: Internet broadband connections by means of cable TV access
- L.L. (other traditional wireline access): Internet broadband connections by means of dedicated capacity (Leased Lines) provided over metallic copper pairs, including tail ends or partial circuits. "Incumbent's leased lines" includes only retail lines and excludes lines provided to other operators. "New entrants' leased lines" includes all retail lines provided to end users, even if based on wholesale lines supplied by the incumbent.
- Other: Internet broadband connections by means of 3G, satellite, fibre optic, powerline communications, etc.
- Retail access: Access provided to end users.
- Incumbents are defined as the organisations enjoying special and exclusive rights or de facto monopoly for provision of voice telephony services before liberalisation, regardless of the role played in the provision of access by means of technologies alternative to the PSTN.
- "New entrants" refers to alternative telecommunications operators, as well as internet service providers (ISPs).
- Broadband capacity: Downstream capacity equal to or higher than 144 Kbit/s

#### **EU OVERVIEW**

The data in this document have been collected by the European Commission, Information Society and Media Directorate General, from national ministries and regulatory authorities. The definitions used have been agreed in the Communications Committee (COCOM).

Throughout the document broadband lines are defined as those with capacity equal to or higher than 144 Kbit/s.

Data refer to 1 July 2007. Data for the Netherlands and Austria refer to 1 April 2007.

In some cases information for some types of access is not available. In a number of countries certain figures are estimates, as the National Regulatory Authorities had not received consolidated data from operators. It should also be noted that in some cases information only refers to major broadband access providers and that broadband access lines provided by other small operators are not included.

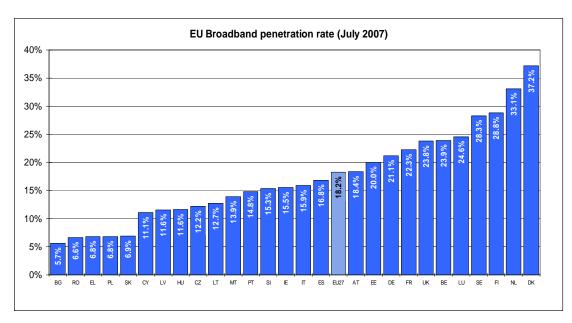
The charts and tables in this document only include fixed broadband lines. Data on 3G mobile subscribers are only available for a limited number of countries and have not been included.

This report includes information from all 27 Member States, including Bulgaria and Romania.

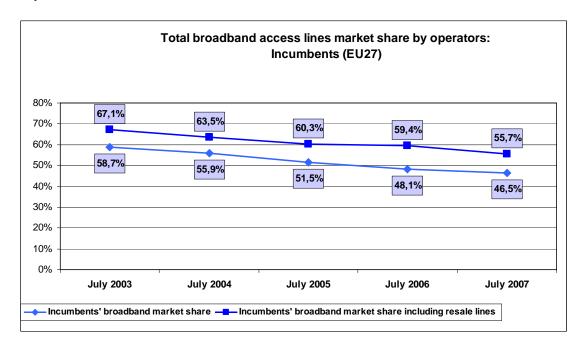
Data for Bulgaria and Romania are included where possible. Given the non-availability of data pre-ceding 1 January 2007, no trends could be established for Bulgaria and Romania.

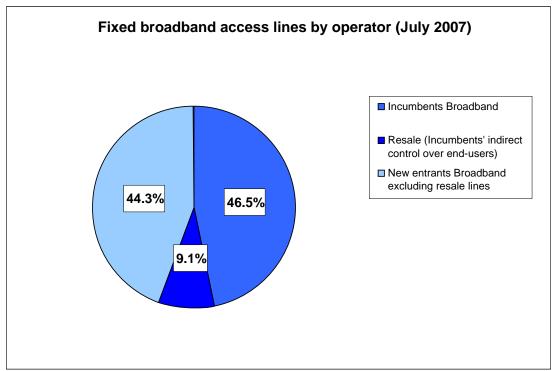
There were 90 207 122 (88 347 916 without Bulgaria and Romania) fixed broadband lines in the EU as of 1 July 2007, a 12.7% increase since 1 January 2007. Of these lines, 72 478 202 were DSL lines (80.3% of total) and 17 728 920 (19.7%) were provided using other transmission means, predominately cable modem.

At EU level the penetration rate, which measures the number of broadband lines per 100 population, is 18.2%, up 3.3 percentage points from 14.9% a year ago.



Incumbent fixed operators provided 46.5% of these lines, continuing the downward trend recorded since 2003. This figure was 55.9% in July 2004, 51.5% in July 2005 and 48.1% in July 2006.





#### RETAIL FIXED BROADBAND LINES

In the period between July 2006 and July 2007 a total of 21 555 543 new broadband lines were added, an increase of 31.4%. Although in relative terms this growth is lower than in the previous twelve month period (42.0%), in absolute numbers it remains higher than the growth recorded between July 2005 and July 2006 (20 301 567 lines). For comparison, new broadband lines added in the period between July 2006 and July 2007 excluding Bulgaria and Romania amounted to 19 696 337 lines, which reveals a deceleration of growth in EU25.

In the period July 2006-July 2007, 82.1% (76.4% with Bulgaria and Romania) of the new lines were by means of xDSL technologies, while 17.9% (23.6% with Bulgaria and Romania) were connections using other type of technologies, which represents a 2.7 percentage point growth of access lines by other means compared to July 2005-July 2006 period (84.8% of new lines were DSL and 15.2% were non-DSL lines).

Table 1 shows how the broadband lines in the EU were distributed between the EU Member States at 1 July 2004, 1 January 2005, 1 July 2005, 1 January 2006, 1 July 2006, 1 January 2007 and 1 January 2007.

Figure 1 shows the distribution of broadband lines by country, Figure 2 presents this distribution in percentage terms at 1 July 2007, and Figure 3 shows the growth rate since January 2003.

Figure 1 EU countries by number of broadband lines

Germany accounts for 19.3% of all broadband lines, followed by the UK and France, with 16.0% and 15.6% respectively. These three countries represent 50.9% of all EU broadband connections. Italy, Spain and the Netherlands follow. The new Member States (EU12) contribute 8.7 million broadband lines, which represent 9.6% of the total, 3.3 points up from July 2006.

The number of broadband lines added per day in the period between July 2006 and July 2007 was 53 963 (without Bulgaria and Romania), i.e. 1 658 connections per day less than 55 621, the number of new lines per day added between July 2005 and July 2006. In other words, in July 2006-July 2007 there were 3.0% fewer lines added every day than a year before.

The absolute growth, without Bulgaria and Romania, in the first half of 2007 – 9 733 776 lines - was 3rd highest semestral increase since January 2003.

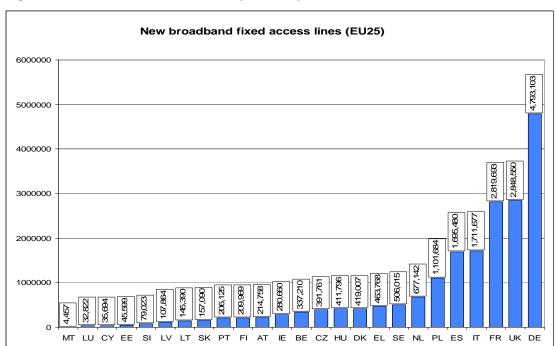


Figure 4 Broadband lines added, by country

Figure 4 shows that Germany, the largest European economy, added 4.8 million new lines in the period between July 2006 and July 2007. Germany was followed by other large Member States (UK, France, Italy and Spain).

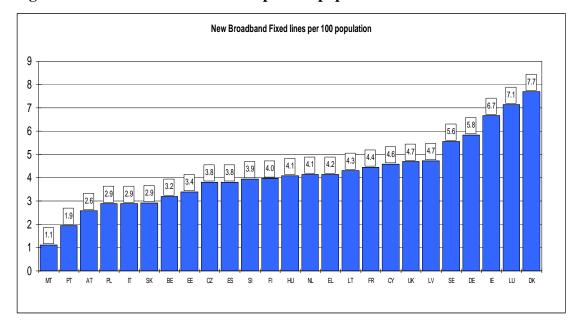


Figure 5 New broadband fixed lines per 100 population

In order to measure the increase in the number of lines relative to the population size, Figure 5 shows the number of new lines per 100 population. Denmark is the leader with 7.7 lines per 100 inhabitants, followed by Luxembourg with 7.1 and Ireland with 6.7 lines per 100 inhabitants.

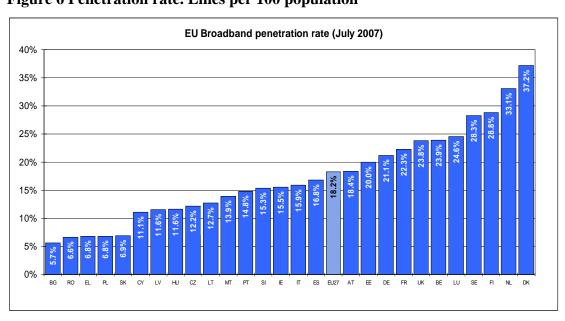


Figure 6 Penetration rate. Lines per 100 population

Figure 6 shows the penetration rate of broadband measured as the number of broadband lines per 100 population. Two countries, Denmark (37.2%) and the Netherlands (33.1%) remain the top performers, with Finland and Sweden approaching rapidly the 30% threshold, while Luxembourg managed to overtake Belgium. UK, France, Germany and Estonia also exceed the 20% mark. At EU level the penetration rate is 18.2%, up 3.3 percentage points from 14.9% a year ago.

Figure 7 combines the penetration rate as of July 2007 and the growth of this indicator in percentage points during the period between July 2006 and July 2007.

Growth was the highest in Denmark, followed by Luxembourg and Ireland. Nine other Member States exceed the EU25 average growth, which stood at 4 percentage points.

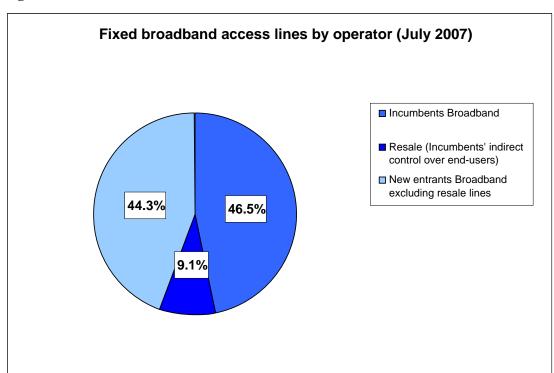


Figure 8 Broadband lines market share

Figure 9 Trend in the percentage of broadband lines provided by the incumbent fixed operators

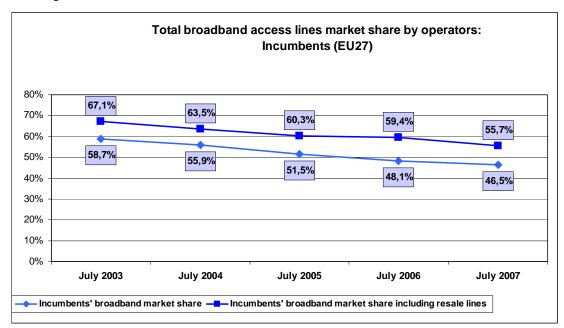
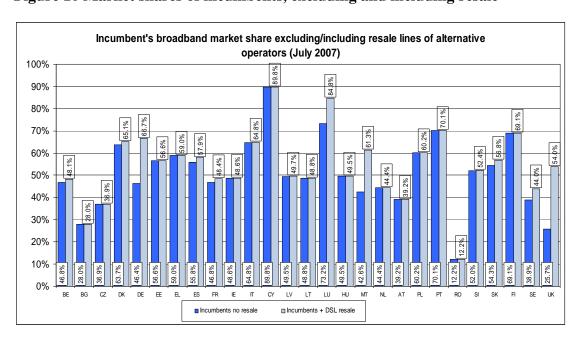


Figure 10 shows the degree of likelihood of incumbents' control over the end-users. In particular, the UK (with 28.3 percentage points difference between the market share of the incumbent excluding and including resale lines of alternative operators), Germany (with 20.3% points), Malta (with 18.7% points) and Luxembourg (with 11.6% points) are good examples of the incumbents' extended market power.

#### **DSL** LINES

There were 72 181 039 (72 478 202 with Bulgaria and Romania) DSL lines in the EU as of 1 July 2007, a 28.9% increase since 1 July 2006.

In the period between July 2006 and July 2007 a total of 16 166 812 (16 463 975 with Bulgaria and Romania) new DSL lines were added. This represents 1 051 923 lines less than 17 218 735, the number of new lines installed in the period between July 2005 and July 2006. This confirms the signs of growth slowdown in DSL segment, the trend revealed towards the end of 2006.

Incumbent fixed operators provided 56.1% of these lines, down from 57.3% in July 2006 and 62.3% in July 2005.

Table 2 shows how the DSL lines in the EU were distributed between the EU Member States at 1 July 2004, 1 January 2005, 1 July 2005, 1 January 2006, 1 July 2006, 1 January 2007 and 1 July 2007.

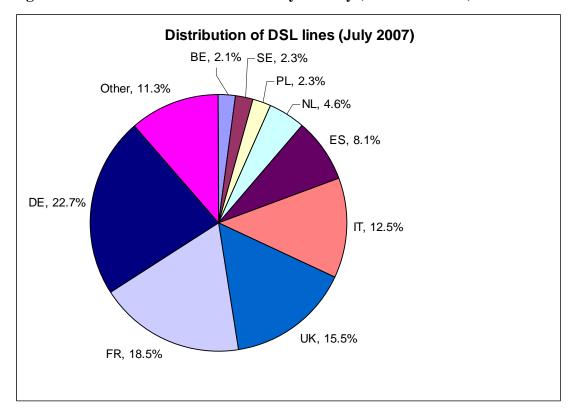

Germany accounts for 22.7% of all DSL lines, followed by France with 18.5% and the UK with 15.5%. These three countries provide 56.7% of all DSL lines, as shown in Figure 12. The new Member States (EU12) contribute 4.3 million DSL lines, which represent 5.9% of the total DSL lines, up by 1.1 points since July 2006.

The number of DSL lines added each day in the period between July 2006 and July 2007 was 44 293 (Bulgaria and Romania not included), which means that 2882 (i.e. 6.1%) connections per day less were added than in the period between July 2005 and July 2006, when 47 175 new DSL connections per day were recorded.

Germany added more than 4.3 million new lines over the period, followed by France, the UK, Italy, Spain and Poland.

Figure 15 DSL lines market share by operator

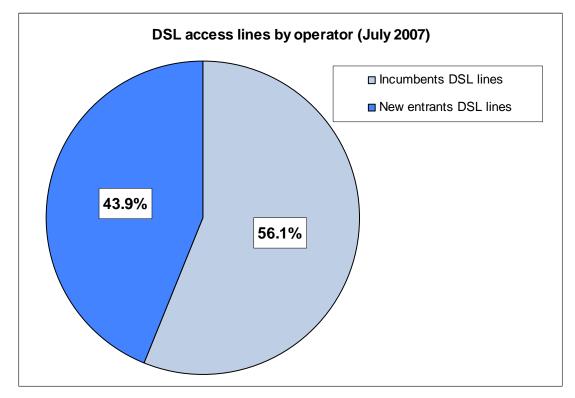


Figure 16 Trend in the % of DSL lines provided by incumbent fixed operators

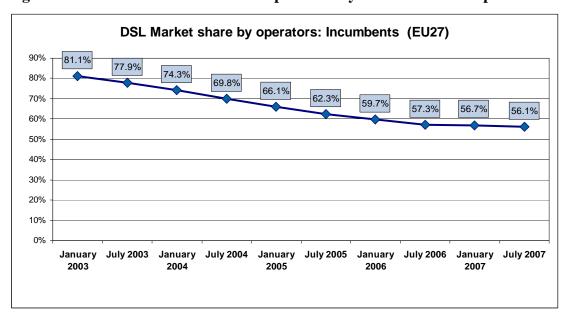


Figure 17 displays the type of access used by new entrants' to provide DSL lines to their customers. Local loop unbundling (fully unbundled lines and shared access) is the main wholesale access for new entrants with 55.4% of DSL lines, up from 45.9% in July 2006. New entrants continue to replace bitstream access (down by 3.1 percentage points since July 2006) for local loop unbundling in the provision of broadband services, as can be seen in Figure 18. Share of resale, which represents a type of access for low-investment intensive new entrants, has shrunken by 6.3 percentage points during the last year.

Figure 17 New entrants' DSL lines by type of access

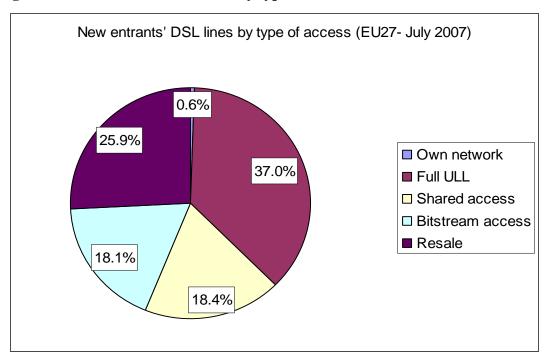
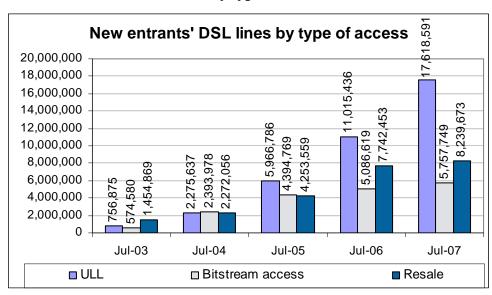


Figure 18 New entrants' DSL lines by type of access



#### FIXED BROADBAND LINES USING TECHNOLOGIES OTHER THAN DSL

There were 16 166 877 (17 728 920 with Bulgaria and Romania) broadband lines using technologies other than DSL in the EU as of 1 July 2007. 3 529 525 lines were added (5 091 568 with Bulgaria and Romania), which represents a 27.9% increase since 1 July 2006. Net additions in the period between July 2006 and July 2007 were higher than in the period between July 2005 and July 2006, when 3 082 832 new lines were sold, pointing at a solid growth of non-DSL segment.

Alternative operators provided 92.6% of these lines, which is on pair with the market share in July 2006.

Table 3 shows how the non-DSL broadband lines in the EU were distributed between the EU Member States at 1 July 2004, 1 January 2005, 1 July 2005, 1 January 2006, 1 July 2006, 1 January 2007 and 1 July 2007.

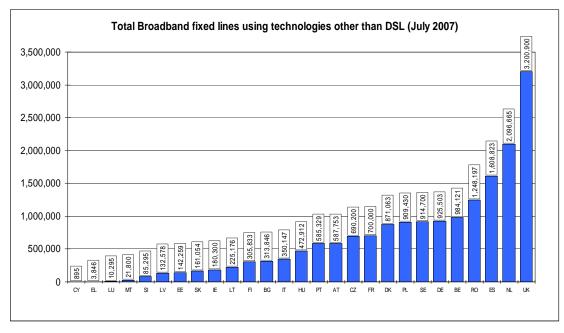

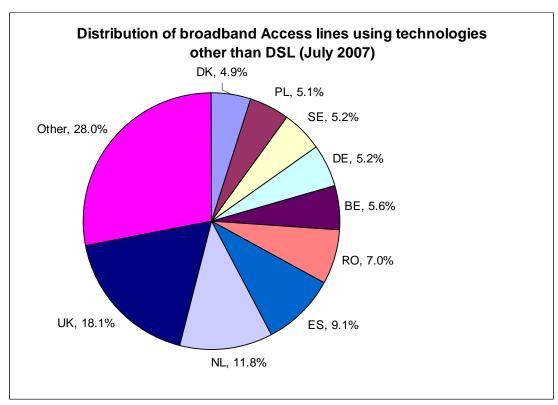

The UK accounts for 18.1% of all broadband lines using other technologies, as shown in Figure 20. The Netherlands has the second largest individual share, with 11.8%, followed by Spain, Romania and Belgium with 9.1%, 7.0% and 5.6% respectively. These five countries account for 51.6% of broadband lines in the EU in this category.

9 670 (Bulgaria and Romania not included) broadband lines using other technologies were added each day in the period between July 2006 and July 2007. This optimistically compares to 8 446 new lines added per day between July 2005 and July 2006.

Poland is the only Member State that has added more than 0.5 million lines using technologies other than DSL since July 2006. Germany contributed with more than 0.4 million new lines in the same period, followed by Spain, the UK, Sweden and Czech Republic.

Figure 23 Broadband lines using other technologies: market share

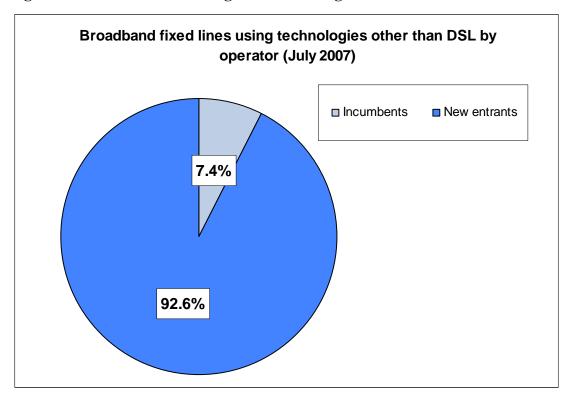
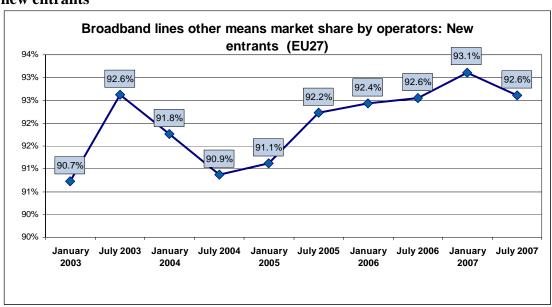


Figure 24 Trend in the % of lines using technologies other than DSL provided by new entrants

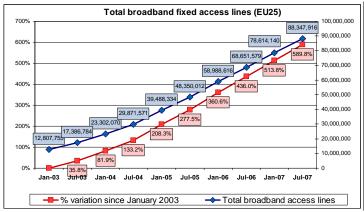

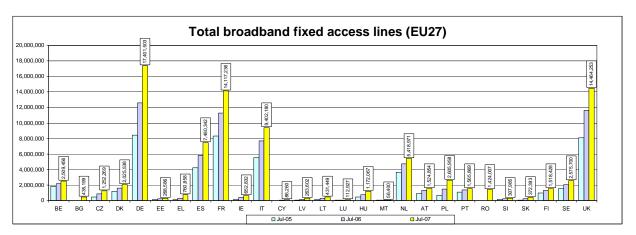

#### Total broadband access retail fixed lines in EU



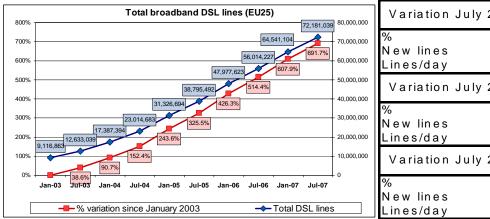

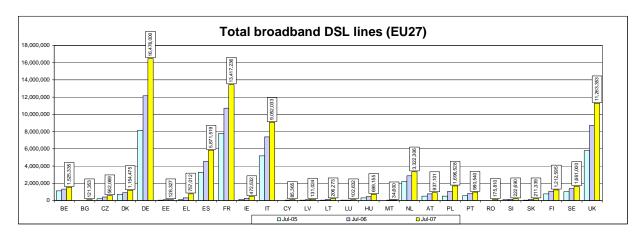

#### Total DSL retail lines in EU



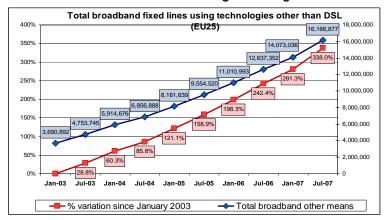

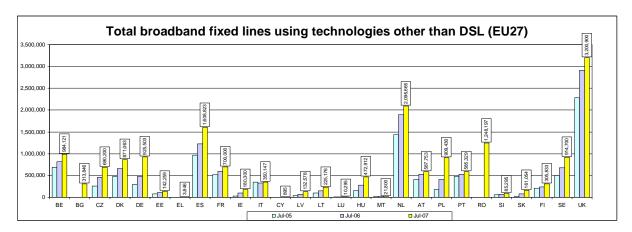

## Total broadband fixed retail lines using technologies other than DSL in EU



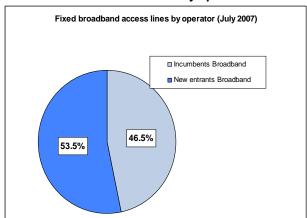
